19/08/18 - Warwick Rural East - Incidents of Note - 18th/19th August 2018

Radford Semele - Crime Reference: 23/34181/18

Attempt Burglary/Vehicle Crime: At approximately 00:45hrs Saturday 18-AUG-2018 an unknown offender attempted to force entry into a public house on Southam Road, Radford Semele. The offender then enters an insecure gold Ford Focus that was parked in the car park. A mobile phone and other items were stolen.

Bubbenhall - Crime Reference: 23/34154/18

Vehicle Crime: Between 09:00hrs and 12:00hrs Saturday 18-AUG-2018 unknown offender(s) forced entry into a white 15 plate Renault that was parked in a layby on the A445 near to the junction with Spring Hill, Bubbenhall. Offender(s) searched the vehicle. A number of items were stolen.

Vehicle Crime: Between 09:00hrs and 12:30hrs Saturday 18-AUG-2018 unknown offender(s) forced entry into a black 51 plate taxi. Offender(s) searched the vehicle and stole a wallet plus contents from the drivers door.

Burglary: Sometime between the evening of Saturday 18-AUG-2018 and 06:45hrs Sunday 19-AUG-2018 unknown offender(s) have entered a residential property on Price Road, Cubbington. Offender(s) have stolen vehicle keys from within the property. Offender(s) have then proceeded to steal a white 62 plate Vauxhall Combo van containing tools.

Burglary: Between 17:30hrs Saturday 18-AUG-2018 and 08:45hrs Sunday 19-AUG-2018 unknown offender(s) forced entry onto the grounds of a commercial property on Stoneleigh Road, Baginton. Offender(s) entered two outbuildings. Offender(s) stole a washing machine, tumble dryer and vacuum cleaner.

17/08/18 - Incidents at premises in Blackdown & Baginton

Please be aware of the following incidents which have occurred at premises in your area over recent days:

Incident 68 of 14 August - During the night of 13 into 14 August, offenders broke into a large number of storage containers at a rural premises in Blackdown. The offenders broke the locks off the containers and stole numerous items from inside them.

Incident 144 of 16 August - Between 9.45 and 10.30am on 16 August, offenders entered a home in Oak Close, Baginton through an insecure window and carried out a tidy search before making off with a handbag, laptop computer, an iPad, watch and a charm bracelet.
