18/01/19 - Courier Fraud

Please be aware that Courier Fraud calls are being made to elderly residents in and around Radford Semele in the last few days.

The calls being made are from fraudsters claiming to be a police officer. They tell you that your bank card details have been used fraudulently and instruct you to go to your bank and transfer money into their account. They also use the method of suggesting you hang up and ring the police station back to ensure the call is genuine....Don't be fooled - they stay on the line. They then tell you to read out or key in your PIN. They send a taxi/courier to your address to collect your bank card. With this and your PIN, they spend your money within a very short time.

JUST REMEMBER:

Your bank or the police will never ask for your PIN or bank card...Do NOT give them to anybody!
