26/02/19 - Warwickshire Rural watch Bulletin - 26 February 2019

Please be aware of the following incidents, which have occurred at farms and rural businesses, across Warwickshire, over recent days:

Incident 57 of 19 February - Farnborough: During the night of 18 into 19 February, offenders broke into a van parked in the yard of a farm premises in Farnborough by smashing a window. They also broke into an outbuilding and stole several brand new chainsaws and several cans of fuel.

Incident 90 of 19 February - Brailes: During the night of 18 into 19 February, offenders forced the locks off the doors of two outbuildings at a farm premises in Brailes and entered the buildings. Once inside, the offenders carried out a search before making off with several Stihl power tools. Neighbours heard a vehicle in the area at around 4am and this may be connected.

Incident 217 of 19 February - Lawsonford: At some point before 2pm on 19 February, offenders entered a farm premises in Preston Road, Lawsonford and stole items of scrap metal.

Incident 171 of 19 February - Dorsington: At some point before 12.15pm on 19 February, offenders stole several Jacob sheep from a field at farm premises in Dorsington, Stratford.

Incident 69 of 23 February - Newton: During the night of 22 into 23 February, offenders broke into a farm premises and broke into pheasant pens, releasing the birds. Nothing appears to have been stolen.

Incident 411 of 20 February - Sawbridge: Between 6pm on 19 February and 6pm on 20 February, offenders broke into an outbuilding at a farm premises in Sawbridge, Rugby and carried out an untidy search but nothing was stolen.

Incident 146 of 24 February - Offchurch: Between 4pm on 22 February and 11.30am on 24 February, offenders broke into the yard of a farm premises in Offchurch and then broke into a barn at the premises. It is not clear exactly what was stolen.

Incident 134 of 21 February - Kineton: During the night of 20 into 21 February, offenders broke into two outbuildings at a rural premises in Kineton and stole a Trek bike and a Halford bike along with a Stihl leaf blower and a Stihl strimmer.

Incident 108 of 20 February - Sawbridge: At just after 9am on 20 February, offenders entered a Land Rover at a farm premises in Sawbridge, Rugby and stole a set of keys in order to open outbuilding in the farm yard. The offender failed to get into the buildings and made off.

Incident 269 of 25 February - Moreton Morrell: During the night of 19 into 20 February, offenders cut the padlocks off the wooden doors of two outbuildings at a farm premises in Moreton Morrell and entered the buildings. The offenders carried out a search but nothing appears to have been stolen.
