Community Messages

17/08/18 - Incidents at premises in Stratford, Bishopton & Shotton

Please be aware of the following incidents, which have occurred at premises in your area over recent days:

Incident 144 of 8 August - During the night of 7 into 8 August, offenders stole two insecure pedal cycles from the rear patio off a home in Birmingham Road, Stratford.

Incident 218 of 11 August - Between 12 midday and 2.20pm on 11 August, offenders smashed the glass in the front door of a home in Loxley Road, Stratford and entered the house. Once inside, the offenders carried out a search before making off with items of jewellery.

Incident 107 of 12 August - During the night of 11 into 12 August, offenders broke the locks off several storage containers at a rural business premises in Bishopton, Stratford and stole numerous items from inside them.

Incident 138 of 10 August - During the night of 9 into 10 August, offenders entered an insecure vehicle parked outside a home in Albany Road, Stratford and carried out an untidy search.

Incident 74 of 11 August - During the night of 10 into 11 August, offenders smashed the drivers side window of a vehicle parked outside a home in Shotton village but nothing appears to have been stolen.

Incident 40 of 16 August - During the night of 15 into 16 August, offenders broke into a home in Shotton Road, Stratford by forcing open the front window. The offenders stole a quantity of cash.

Incident 45 of 16 August - Between 5 and 6am 16 August, offenders broke into a home in Loxley Road, Stratford through a kitchen window and stole the keys to a vehicle parked outside. The offenders activated the car intruder alarm as they entered it but managed to drive it away.
