05/03/18 - Theft of Mercedes Sprinter Van, Curdworth

The van, which is black in colour, is valued in excess of £10,000 and was stolen from the Industrial Estate located on Kingsbury Road, Curdworth.

The van was stolen without the keys and it is believed that the offenders have stolen the vehicle using key coding equipment.

Owners of commercial vehicles are being asked to look at the security of their vehicles, it may be worthwhile in investing in aftermarket immobiliser systems or physical barriers such as steering wheel locks or driveway bollards which physically prevent the vehicle from being driven away.

07/03/18 - Incidents at homes in Atherstone Road, Queens Way, East House Drive, Highview and Foul End, Hurley

Please be aware of the following incidents, which have occurred at homes in Hurley over recent days:

Incident 132 of 3 March - During the night of 2 into 3 March, offenders broke into a garage at the side of a home in Atherstone Road, Hurley by forcing open the up and over door. Nothing appears to have been stolen.

Incident 92 of 3 March - During the same night, offenders broke into a vehicle parked on the driveway of a home in Atherstone Road, Hurley and carried out a search. Several items were stolen.

Incident 109 of 3 March - Again on the same night, offenders broke into a vehicle parked on the driveway of a home in Queens Way, Hurley and stole several items including a dash cam, tools and a torch.

Incident 163 of 4 March - During the night of 2 into 3 March, offenders entered a secure vehicle parked on the driveway of a home in East House Drive, Hurley and carried out an untidy search. Two sets of keys, a phone charger and a service book were stolen. The service book was later recovered nearby.

Incident 100 of 5 March - During the same night, offenders entered an insecure vehicle parked on the driveway of a home in Highview, Hurley. Nothing appears to have been stolen.

Incident 14 of 5 March - At around 4.10am on 5 March, a witness saw 3 male offenders attempt to steal a pressure cleaner from a rural home in Foul End, Hurley. When they realised they had been discovered, the offenders made off in a light coloured flat bed Ford Transit. Nothing was taken.
