Based at Alcester Police Station, The Safer Neighbourhood team's primary roles are around crime prevention, problem solving both long standing or emerging issues of community concern and community engagement. We are supported at Alcester by colleagues from Patrol teams whose role is to respond to incidents and investigate crimes that occur in the area 24/7. The SNT is supervised by Inspector Jake Kibblewhite who leads on Neighbourhood Policing for Stratford District and Sgt Ebbs who also oversees neighbourhood Policing in the Shipston on Stour area. The Alcester SNT currently consists of 2 Police officers and 5 Police Community Support Officers, and our contact details are shown above.

Appeal for witnesses following collision in Arrow.

We're appealing for witnesses or dashcam footage following a collision in Arrow, Alcester, on Sunday 10 August.

The two-vehicle collision involved a motorcyclist and the driver of a red car. It happened at around 10.30am on the A435 roundabout, at the junction of Evesham Street and the A422.

The motorcyclist sustained serious injuries and was taken to hospital by ambulance.

Rape investigation - Alcester.

An investigation has been launched following a reported rape near Alcester.

Officers were called at around 11.40pm, Friday 22 August to a festival at Ragley Hall.

A 16-year-old boy from Redditch has been arrested and is currently in police custody.

A number of enquiries are currently ongoing, and a scene guard is in place at the location.

The victim - a teenage girl of a similar age - is currently being supported by specialist officers.
