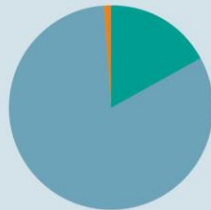
Less than **3.5%** of incidents involved use of force

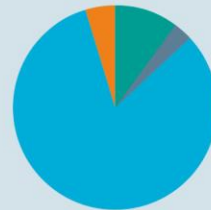

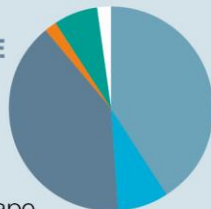

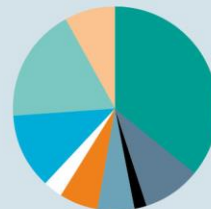
REASON FOR USE OF FORCE: *

36% Struggle
