Out and about with Bedworth East SNT

This month SNT have been tackling the ongoing issue of ASB being caused in the town centre and across parks and residential areas of Bedworth. An Operation Cera has been created whereby we organise the SNT officers from both Nuneaton and Bedworth to join up and flood the town as a group. Our aim is to provide high visibility and deter or intercept any nuisance behaviour that we come across. By conducting these high visibility patrols with a large team of us, we have been able to identify a handful of individuals and have issued ASB letters. Our PSP has at present got 42 updates, and we have a live tasking that is accumulating more data.

Officers were called to an incident on the Tree's Estate on Tregorrick Road, where a large cannabis grow was uncovered in 4 rooms of the house. The plants were destroyed and the house was stripped of any electrical hazards.

Operation 6 is in full headway and individuals and businesses are seeing the tighter restrictions coming into play. Each day, 2 officers are allocated to focussing their efforts on supporting the Governments aims to stay home, control the virus and save lives. We challenge those not adhering to the new restrictions and conduct patrols to monitor the beat area to this effect.

Our Police Dual Purpose Motorcycle Team have been out covering each end of every park, industrial estate and field to police the ongoing issue of off-road motorbikes and dealing with traffic offences. We have 4 officers that dedicate a number of shifts a week to safely manage this issue, reaching areas that a patrol car cannot get to!

Update on our priorities

2020 Priorities for Bedworth East SNT:

- Vehicle Crime- vehicles being tampered with, broken into or stolen.
- Anti-social behaviour in the town centre- cannabis being smoked, alcohol being consumed underage and rubbish and damage being caused.
- Ensuring that businesses and individuals are adhering to the rule of Six, wearing facemasks when in public places and abiding by the 10pm curfew when choosing to wine and dine!
- Off-road and nuisance motorbikes riding antisocially round residential areas and dangerously driving in our parks and fields.

Uncovered Cannabis Grow

Officers were alerted to suspicious activity after a man was seen waving what looking like a sharp metal object outside of an address on Tregorrick Road.

Upon entering, officers found smashed glass from the front door, blood spatter on the floor and then a large cannabis grow. Approximately 4 rooms of this detached house were being utilised to accommodate the production of these plants.

The glass was cleaned up and the plants were safely disposed of. Investigations are pending further.
