## Parking Enforcement in North Warwickshire

**North Warwickshire have new parking enforcement.**

Parking charges in North Warwickshire commenced from Monday 21st February 2022.

You have up to 2 hours FREE parking, **but you will still need to print a ticket.**

PC Walton, PCSO Jenkins, PCSO Snape and PCSO Hodson supported civil enforcement, housing associations and council in executing evictions at three properties across Atherstone town for offences including criminal ASB incidents and non payment of rent arrears. This is after the Police acted on information from the local community!

Kenneth was found safe and well! We would like to say a big thank you to the community for their help and support in the search. It was lovely to see everyone in the community work together in such a difficult situation.

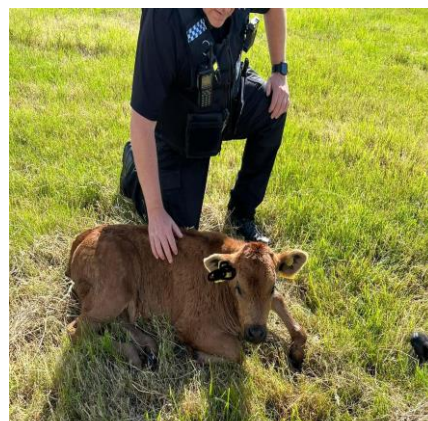
## Good news!

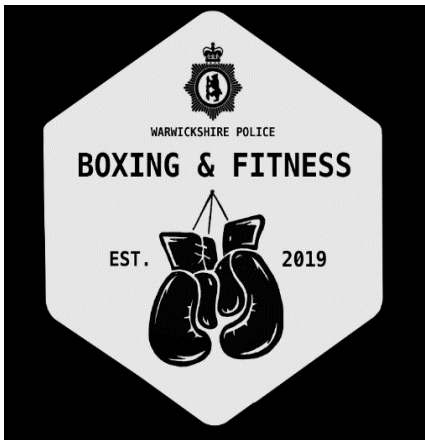
