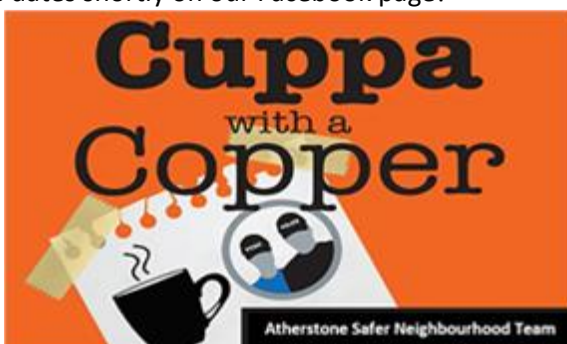
PCSO Jenkins has conducted speed checks in Hartshill and Mancetter. The speed limit is there for a reason and please drive within the limit

Local arrests and evictions!

Officers from the Rural Crime Team and Local SNT responded to reports of a quad bike being ridden anti socially in the Mancetter area. On arrival the quad was located, its rider was well known by the attending officers having caused several previous issues locally. Checks of the male were completed and it was soon established that he was wanted for a Racially Aggravated Public Order Offence.

1 male arrested and 1 nuisance quad bike off the street!

Officers from Local SNT arrested three suspects in Dordon after being linked to vehicle crime offences. Investigation still on going.

A male has been charged with being drunk and disorderly after an incident that occurred in Greendale Road, Atherstone.

The suspect will appear at Coventry Court on 25/11/22.

He has also been given bail conditions and served a community protection warning concerning behaviour in Market Square, Atherstone.

A male and female from the Queens Road area of Atherstone have been evicted from their property after partnership working with the local council. The occupants were linked to ASB, crime and drugs. They also were breaching tenancy conditions. After a court hearing an eviction process has taken place.

Warwickshire Police are currently recruiting special constables.

Could you be a local hero and become a special constable?

Our Special constables are voluntary, part-time police officers who work in some of the most important areas of modern policing. Would you be willing to make a real difference to communities in the Leamington, Stratford, Rugby, Nuneaton and North Warwickshire areas?

As a fully-trained Special constable, you will have full police powers, wear a police uniform and work alongside regular police officers and police staff, with opportunities for promotion and to develop your leadership and management skills.

In return, you will be required to commit a minimum of 16 hours a month, although many people do significantly more as the hours can be flexible to fit around your work and home life commitments.

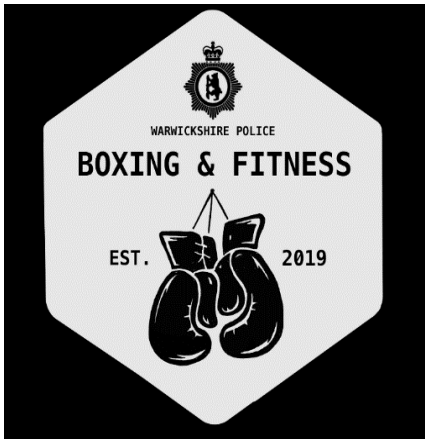
