## A very expensive new car

On Friday 4<sup>th</sup> February, officers from Coleshill received a couple of calls about a vehicle driving erratically.



Police officers in North Warwickshire were made aware of a car driving erratically in the Nether Whitacre area after two separate members of the public called in with concerns. The calls stated that the car was speeding up and slowing down and at one point was travelling on the wrong side of the road.

After searching the area the car was located and stopped on the roundabout at Junction 9 of the M42. The officers were expecting to find the driving under the influence of drink or drugs....no. It was a new car and he hasn't driven it before! Not sure that's an excuse for driving on the wrong side of the road though and to make matters worse he hasn't bothered to sort any insurance out before making the journey from where he purchased the car to where he wanted to go in Woking! On Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> of February our OPU officers stopped a vehicle at Corley Services.

The officers contacted the Insurance Company who had NO record of the policy.

The driver was reported to Court and the vehicle seized.

Big thank you to members of the public, farmers and the local council for helping remove trees from the roads, keeping it clear and safe for road users.

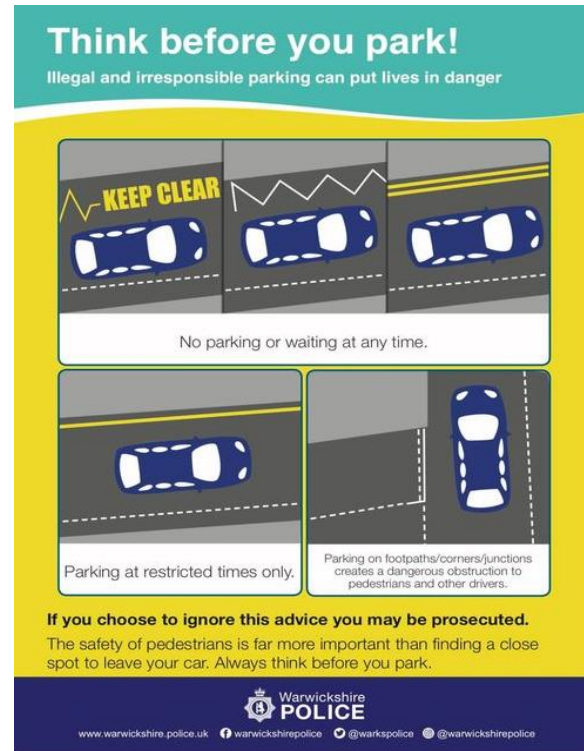
