Incidents reported during January 2021:

Covid-19 regulations:

The police have followed up reports by telephone and online from concerned members of the public reporting alleged breaches of the current regulations in public places, shops, work sites and homes. Fines have been issued where breaches have occurred. Visits have also been made to people who are required to be in quarantine.

Wellesbourne Area:

102-15/01 Vicinity of Wellesbourne Sports and Community centre, Loxley Close, Wellesbourne

Report of a walker, with dog on lead, being bitten on the knee by another dog off lead, possibly a black Labrador. The owner of the attacking dog, a woman, offered no support or details.

085-18/01 Wellesbourne Household Waste, Dovehouse drive, Wellesbourne

Forced entry to container between 16:00 17/01 and 10:00 18/01 but nothing stolen.

404-30/01 Horseshoe Crescent, Wellesbourne

Report of offenders disturbed whilst trying to enter car. Car was found to have been damaged by 'keying' and tyres punctured.

Vehicle stolen. Noise heard approx. 04:00.

341-18/01 Camp Lane, Warmington


Report of fly tipping. Later found to be approx. 30 bags of fibre compost and decayed plants which appear to be remnants of a cannabis grow.
