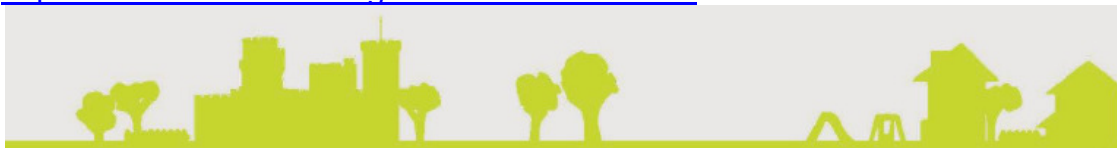
Kenilworth Community Forum

Below is a selection of incidents that have occurred in the Kenilworth and Burton Green area during March 2018.

Abbey Ward
