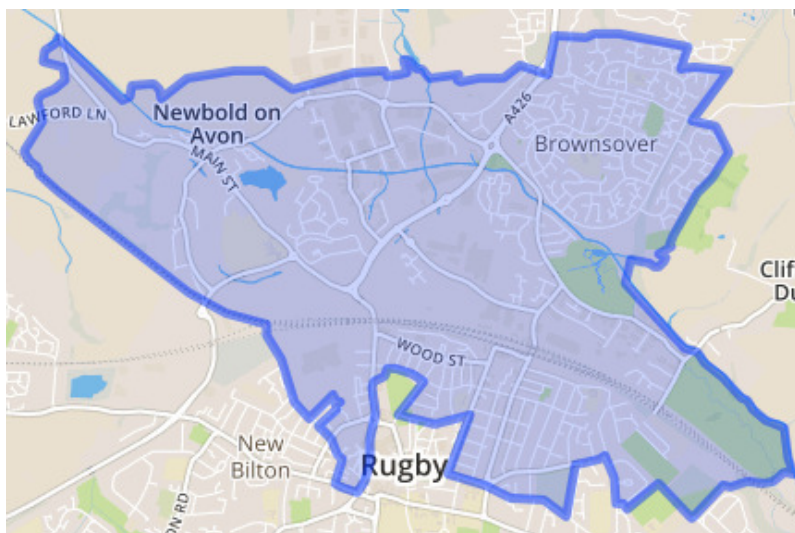

### Crime Overview

This section looks at the crimes of public interest that have occurred on the Rugby Town North Safer Neighbourhood Team policing area for the month of January. Below is a brief summary of some of the incidents that have been reported to us over the last month:

### Anti-Social Behaviour:

There have been a total of 65 Incidents of Anti-Social Behaviour reported to us for the Rugby Town North Area. These jobs consist of a variety of incidents, including youths causing ASB at the local retail parks and ongoing neighbour disputes. This is a massive decrease since last month.

### Burglaries:

There have been 14 reports of Burglaries in the Rugby Town North Area, a statistic which is combination of both commercial business premises and residential properties. This figure has decreased since last month. On-going patrols on the area will continue.

### **Theft:**

Theft from the local retail parks continues to be a trend that is reported to us with 42 incidents reported; particularly at Junction One and Elliot's Field and other main supermarkets on the area. This is mainly shoplifting, but also theft of pedal cycles.

### **Vehicle Crime:**

There have been a total of 21 thefts from motor vehicles. This is an increase since last month. SNT will continue patrols in the area to deter vehicle crime.

## **Appeals News and Updates/Information and Advice**

We are still getting reports of dangerous parking outside schools in the area.

Please be reminded that the safety of your children is paramount and we will continue to patrol and issue tickets to dangerous and obstructive vehicles.

**Think before you park!**

Illegal and irresponsible parking can put lives in danger.  
Remember the following:

<p>No parking or waiting during school hours.</p>	<p>No parking or waiting at any time.</p>
<p>Parking at restricted times only.</p>	<p>Parking on footpaths/corners/junctions creates a dangerous obstruction to pedestrians and other drivers.</p>

**If you choose to ignore this advice you may be prosecuted.**  
The safety of your and other people's children is far more important than finding a close spot to leave your car. Always think before you park.

## Legal Highs in Winfield Rec

We have recently found a substantial amount of empty gas canisters used for legal highs in the car park of Winfield Rec. The team will be paying close attention to the park to deter people from using these so called 'Legal highs'. They can be dangerous and we advise people to not use them.
